Following the game show, Mr. T. Madhurendran Ajit Singh, parent of Ashley XII A addressed the gathering with an inspiring speech on Holistic Development.


To bring the experiences of alumni to light, the assembly featured a Mystery Box Activity inviting them to share fond memories and transformative moments from their time at school.


The assembly was a true testament to how DAV fosters Human Excellence not just academically but in all spheres of life, through real-time opportunities to exhibit competence, creativity, and character.




Mind Maze – Brilliance in Quiz
