ADVISORY

The season for vector borne diseases like Dengue & Chikungunya is in full swing. These diseases are caused by Aedes mosquito which requires stagnant water to lay eggs. Hence we should not create any mosquitogenic situation in our city conducive for Aedes breeding. All the residents of Chandigarh are further advised to follow the preventive measures given below to protect themselves from vector borne diseases like Dengue & Chikungunya.
